General Responsibilities

Teaching:

*If this position is filled as a full-time position, in addition to teaching, responsibilities may include coaching two seasons of the afternoon program, dorm parenting, advising, and chaperone duties. With teaching faculty status comes the expectation of total involvement in the lives of students on campus. Campus housing may be available

B.A. in Spanish, M.A. preferred; Spanish teaching experience preferred; native or near-native fluency in Spanish preferred; experience in coaching and/or playing interscholastic athletics or afternoon programs preferred; must be able to work collegially; must be committed to working in a diverse community and have the ability to communicate effectively with diverse populations; must enjoy working with young people in a boarding school environment and have a valid driver's license.
